Adams County is home of 2011 "Super Bull"

AMES, IOWA – The winner of the Iowa State Fair's "Super Bull Contest" is a 6-year-old Charolais bull named Bubba. Bubba is owned by Iowa Cattlemen's Association member, Jim Stalcup, of Stalcup Farms Charolais, Prescott.

Bubba weighed in at 2,768 pounds, 636 pounds lighter than record-holder 'Big Black.' (Big Black became the record holder at the 2009 fair. He was an Angus bull also owned by Stalcup Farms Charolais and Joe Holub of What Cheer.)

The second-place bull in the 2011 contest is Tarzan, a Shorthorn bull owned by Diamond W Enterprise of Boone. The bull representing ICA member Sterling Weeda's farm weighed 2,705 pounds.

The third-place bull was Colorado, another Charolais bull belonging to Stalcup Farms Charolais. Colorado weighed 2,583 pounds.

The top three winners received \$750, \$450, and \$300 respectively. The premium money was provided by the Iowa Cattlemen's Association, Hawkeye Breeders Service of Adel, and the Iowa State Fair.
