Lease rates are \$7/head. •Cattle are committed, or turned in, by noon Tuesday, the week before delivery. •The cattle are based off the IA/MN dressed delivered market, reported by USDA, that occurs the week prior to harvest, plus \$1/cwt. All feeders shipping	90

		during the same delivery week are priced on the same grid, with the same base. • Since we start with 'dressed delivered', the feeder pays all the freight to Tama, IA. • Cattle can be of any hide color. However, NO Brahman influence. The following are also not allowed: cows, lactating females, bulls, heiferettes, stags, straight Holstein or dairy breeds, blind cattle, foundered cattle, or horns extending past the tip of the ear. Beef x dairy cross is allowed, provided they have adequate muscle conformation. • Consultation is available to help the feeder understand the grid and the resulting data.
